

Word Study: Resurrection

Luke 20:27 Sadducees denied the **resurrection**.

Matt 22:29 You do error, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.

Luke 20:34 The children of this world marry, and are given in marriage. But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the **resurrection** from the dead, do not marry, neither can they die any more: for they are equal unto the angels; and are the children of God, being the **children of the resurrection**. Vs 38 God is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto Him.

John 11:23 Jesus told Martha, Your brother will rise again. She said, I know he will: in **the resurrection** at the last day. Jesus said, "**I AM the resurrection**, and the life: he that believes in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live. And whoever lives and believes in me shall never die! Do you believe this, Martha? Yes, she says, I believe you are the Christ, the Messiah, the Anointed One, the Son of God, who should come into the world.

Peter believed in the resurrection.

Acts 2:22 Ye men of Israel, hear this: Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you...you have taken and crucified and slain: Whom God has raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be held by it. Vs 29: David is both dead and buried, and his sepulcher is with us to this day. Vs 34: David is not ascended into the heavens, vs 31L but seeing this before he spoke of **the resurrection of Christ**. Vs 32: This Jesus has God raised up! And know assuredly, that God has made the same Jesus, whom you have crucified, both Lord and Christ.

And the people cried out, What shall we do?

Then Peter said to them, "Repent, repent, and be baptized...every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ." Verse 38.

Acts 4 Peter and John had healed the lame man in chapter 3, and the Sadducees "Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Jesus **the Resurrection** from the dead" Laid hands on them. Vs 7: By what power, or by what name, have you done this? And Peter said, "By the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, but whom God **raised from the dead**"

Acts 17 Paul preached to the Epicureans and Stoics of Jesus and **the resurrection**. They said this is a strange doctrine.

Paul said, Why is that so strange? You have an altar TO THE UNKNOWN GOD.

That's the God that made the world and everything in it, He is Lord of heaven and earth. He doesn't dwell in temples made with hands, but he gives to all life, and breath, and all things.

And has given assurance to all men,
in that **He raised Jesus from the dead.**

Acts 24:14 before Felix, Paul said, “**This I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, So worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law.**”
“And have hope toward God, that there shall be **a resurrection of the dead.**”

Rom 1 Paul preached the “gospel of God...concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord...And declared to be the Son of God with power, by **the resurrection from the dead.**”

Rom 6:3 “Don’t you know that as many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?...that
“**As Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life**”
“For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall also be in the likeness of **his resurrection.**”

1Cor 15:12 Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how can some (Sadducees) say there is no resurrection? Vs 19 “If in this life **ONLY** we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable”

But now is Christ **risen from the dead!** And become the firstfruits of them that slept.”

Vs 22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive! But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ’s at His coming.

John 5:25 **The hour is coming and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live!**

1Thess 4:16,17 **The Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel!**

1Cor 15:42 So is **the resurrection of the dead.**

It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption:

It is sown in dishonor; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power!

It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body.

The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

John 5:21 For as **the Father raises up the dead** and quickens them, so also the Son quickens whomsoever he will.

1Cor 15:51 Behold, I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and **the dead shall be raised** incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on

incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. ..Then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written,

Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? But thanks be to God, which gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Phil 3:8 I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: For whom I have suffered the loss of all things...vs 10 that I may know him, and **the power of his resurrection**, and the fellowship of his sufferings.

Phil 3:11 If by any means I might attain unto **the resurrection of the dead**.

Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after.

Vs 13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended, but

“This one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind,

And reaching forth unto those things which are before

I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling

I press toward the mark of God in Jesus Christ”

1Peter 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to His abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, 5 Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 6 Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: 7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perishes, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:
