

Word Study – Teach 150 (SOP: 17,313)

Exo 4:12 Moses, “I will be with your mouth, and **teach** you what you shall say”

Exo 24:12 “I will give you a law and commandments which I have written, that you may **teach** them”

Lev 10:10,11 “No alcohol, that you may **teach** the children of Israel all the statutes the Lord spoke”

Deu 6:6 And the words which I command you this day, **teach** them diligently to your children,

Talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down,
When you rise up. Bind them as a sign upon your hand, and between your eyes.

Write them on your door posts, and on your gates.

Deu 31:19 God said, write this song for you, and **teach** it to the children of Israel, (Deu 32)

Put it in their mouths, that this song may be a witness for me. FIRST SCRIPTURE SONG

Judges 13:8 Manoah prayed, O Lord, let the man of God come and **teach** us what we shall do

1Sam 12:23 People wanted a king, Samuel said, But I will **teach** you the good and right way!

1Kings 8:36 Solomon’s dedication prayer, “If thy people, who are called by Thy name,...

Then hear in heaven, and forgive their sins, and **teach** them the good way to walk

2Chr 17:8 Jehoshaphat sent Levites and Priests to **teach** throughout the cities of Judah

Ezra 7:25 King Artaxerxes’s Decree: “set judges to **teach** them that know not the laws of your God”

Job 12:7 Job says, “Ask the beasts, they shall **teach** you, the birds, they shall tell you;

Speak to the earth, it will **teach** you, and the fishes shall declare to you:

The hand of the Lord has wrought all this...He is the Creator

Job 21:22 Job asks, “Shall anyone **teach** God knowledge?” Rhetorical question!

Isa 40:13 Who has directed the Spirit of the Lord, or being His counselor has **taught** Him?

1Cor 2:16 Who has known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him?

But we have the mind of Christ.

Psalms 25:4 Show me thy ways, O Lord; **teach** me thy paths; lead me in thy truth, and **teach** me.

Vs 12 the man that fears the Lord, Him shall He **teach** in the way that He shall choose.

Psalms 27:11 **Teach** me your way, O Lord, and lead me in a plain path. SCRIPTURE SONG!

Vs 1 “The Lord is my light, my strength, and salvation, of whom then shall I be afraid?

Vs 14 “Wait on the Lord, be of good courage, and He shall strengthen thy heart”

Vs 5 “In the time of trouble He shall hide me, in the pavilion of His love”

Psalms 32:8 I will instruct thee and **teach** thee in the way which thou shalt go:

I will guide thee with mine eye.

Psalms 51:7,9,10,11 Purge me with hyssop, Create in me a clean heart, renew a right spirit in me,

Take not thy Holy Spirit from me, restore to me the joy of thy salvation, thy free spirit.

THEN will I teach transgressors Thy ways, and sinners shall be converted unto Thee

Psalms 86:11 **Teach** me thy way, O Lord; I will walk in thy truth

I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart, I will glorify thy name for evermore.

Psalms 119:10,11 With my whole heart have I sought Thee, O let me not wander from

Thy commandments, **Thy word** have I hid, in my heart that I might not sin against Thee!

12 Blessed art Thou, O Lord: **teach** me thy statutes.

14 I have rejoiced in the way of Thy testimonies 15 I will meditate in thy precepts

16 I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget **thy word**.

Psalms 119:97 O how I love thy law! It is my meditation all the day.

Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies;

for they are ever with me. I have more understanding than all my **teachers**.

Psalms 119:135 Make thy face to shine upon thy servant; and **teach** me thy statutes.

Rivers of water run down my eyes, because they keep not thy law.

Prov 5:12-16 I hated instruction, and have not obeyed the voice of my **teachers**,

nor inclined my ear to them that instructed me, I drank waters out of my own cistern/well

Jer 2:13 My people have committed two evils: forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and...

Isa 2:3 Come let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob; Micah 4:2

And He will **teach** us His ways, and we will walk in His paths, the law, the word of the Lord

Isa 28:9 Whom shall he **teach** knowledge, whom shall he make to understand doctrine?

10 For precept must be upon precept, line upon line; here a little, there a little.

1Cor 2:13 not man's wisdom, but what the Spirit **teaches**: comparing spiritual things with spiritual

Jer 32:32,33 Israel and Judah provoked me to anger. They turned unto me the back, and not the face

Tho I taught them, rising up early and **teaching** them, yet they have not received instruction

Eze 44:23 The faithful priests shall **teach** my people the difference between holy and profane

AA 17.2 "the greatest **Teacher** the world has ever known."

Matt 4:23 Jesus went...**teaching** in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom,

and healing all manner of sickness and disease 9:35

Mark 4:1 He began to **teach** by the sea side

Mark 6:2 **teaching** in the synagogue: many hearing him were astonished

Matt 5:19 Whoever shall do [commandments] and **teach** them shall be called great in the kingdom

Luke 11:1 Disciples came to Jesus, "**Teach** us to pray as John taught his disciples"

John 3:2 Nicodemus came, "We know that you are a **teacher** come from God"

Luke 12:11,12 When they bring you into the synagogues, take no thought what you shall say:

For the Holy Spirit shall **teach** you in the same hour what you ought to say.

Matt 10:20 It is not you that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaks in you.

John 9:33 Man born blind to leaders: "If this man were not of God, he could do nothing."

John 9:34 Pharisees to man born blind: "You were born in sin, and do you **teach** us?" **teach**

John 14:26 The Comforter, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will **teach**...

Matt 26:55 Mob comes with Judas: "I sat daily with you **teaching** in the temple, you took me not"

Matt 28:19,20 Go and **teach** all nations (what?)...teaching them to observe all things I commanded

Acts 1:1,2 Jesus began to **teach** until the day he was taken up...teaching to the very last minute

Acts 4:18 Jewish leaders commanded Peter and John to not speak or **teach** in the name of Jesus

Acts 5:25 "The men you put in prison are standing in the temple, **teaching** the people!" ...vs 41

Acts 18:4 Paul reasoned in the synagogue every Sabbath, persuading Jews and Greeks.

Vs 11 He continued in Corinth a year and six months, **teaching** the word of God among them

Acts 9:20 Paul blinded, then restored: Straightway preached Christ that he is the Son of God.

1Cor 12:28 God has set some in the church, first apostles, then prophets, thirdly teachers

Rom 12:4-7 Many members, one body, having different gifts according to the grace given us.

Whether of prophecy, let us prophesy. Or of ministry, let us minister. Or of **teaching**, teach!

Vs 10 But be kindly affectionate one to another with brotherly love, preferring one another in honor.

2Tim 2:24 The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to **teach**, patient,

In meekness instructing those that oppose them.

Our life is to be bound up with the life of Christ; we are to draw constantly from Him, partaking of Him, the living Bread that came down from heaven, drawing from a fountain ever fresh, ever giving forth its abundant treasures. If we keep the Lord ever before us, allowing our hearts to go out in thanksgiving and praise to Him, we shall have a continual freshness in our religious life. Our prayers will take the form of a conversation with God as we would talk with a friend. He will speak His mysteries to us personally. Often there will come to us a sweet joyful sense of the presence of Jesus. Often our hearts will burn within us as He draws nigh to commune with us as He did with Enoch. When this is in truth the experience of the Christian, there is seen in his life a simplicity, a humility, meekness, and lowliness of heart, that show to all with whom he associates that he has been with Jesus and learned of Him. [CO129.3] In those who possess it, the religion of Christ will reveal itself as a vitalizing, pervading principle, a living, working, spiritual energy. There will be manifest the freshness and power and joyousness of perpetual youth. 130.1 This experience gives **every teacher of truth** the very qualifications that will make him a representative of Christ. 130.2
