WordStudy – Judge 227 verses

Gen 15:13,14 Thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs...and that nation...will I judge.

Gen 18:25 That the righteous should be as the wicked...Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

Gen 30:6 God has judged me, heard my voice, given me a son, therefore his name was Dan.

Gen 49:16 Dan shall judge his people, as one of the tribes of Israel.

Psalm 7:11 God **judges the righeous** and is angry with the wicked every day...15 He made a pit, and digged it, and is fallen into the ditch which he made. 16 His mischief shall return upon his own head. His violent dealings upon his own scalp.

Psalm 9:7 The Lord has prepared His throne for **judgment**, and He shall judge the world in **righteousness**.

Psalm 9:16 The Lord is known by the **judgment** which He executes: the wicked is snared in the workd of his own hands.

Psalm 10:17,18 Lord, Thou hast heard the desire of the humble...to judge the fatherless and the oppressed.

Psalm 50:1-5 The mighty God, Our God shall come, and shall not keep silent, He shall call to the heavens from above, that He may **judge His people**. Gather my saints together unto Me; those that have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice. 8 I will not reprove thee for thy sacrifices or thy burnt offerings... 9 I will take no bullock out of thy house, nor he goats out of thy folds. 10 For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills.

Psalm 67:3 O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for Thou shalt **judge** the people **righteously**.

Psalm 68:5 A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is God in His holy habitaiton.

Psalm 72:2 He shall **judge** thy people **with righteousess**, and the poor with judgment. The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by **righteousness**.

Psalm 82:1,3 God stands in the congregation of the mighty; he judges among the gods. **Defend the poor and the fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy. Deliver the poor and needy**; rid them out of the hand of the wicked.

Prov 31:9 Open they mouth, judge righteously, ad plead the cause of the poor and needy.

Isa 11:1-4 The Spirit of the Lord (7) shall rest upon a Branch...He shall **not judge after the sight of eyes**, neither reprove after the hearing of His ears: but **with righteousness** He shall j**udge the poor**...with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips shall He slay the wicked.

John 7:24 Judge not according to appearance, but **judge righteous judgment**.

Isaiah 1:17 Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.

Vs 18 Come now, and let us reason together saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

Isaiah 3:13 The Lord stands up to plead, and stands to judge the people. All rise!

Daniel 12:1 Then shall Michael stand up...

Acts 7:55 Stephen saw **Jesus standing** on the right hand of God.

Micah 5:1 They shall smite **the judge of Israel** with a rod upon the cheek.

Luke 6:36 Be ye therefore merciful (perfect Matt 6), as your Father also is merciful.

37 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged, condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned;

Forgive and ye shall be forgiven: 38 **Give**, and it shall be given unto you:

Good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over...

Luke 7:41-43 There was a creditor and two debtors: one owed 500 pence, the other 50. 10:1 difference.

He frankly forgave both. God is no respector of persons. Simon, which of them will love him most?

I suppose, him to whom he forgave most. "Thou hast rightly judged."

1Pet 1:17 the Father, who without respect of persons, judges according to every man's work.

Romans 2:1 Wherein you judge another, you judge yourself; for you that judges do the same things.

Luke 18:1-5 An unjust judge, judges right for the importunant widow.

John 7:22 the Father judges no man, but has committed all judgment unto the Son.

Acts 10:41,42 He rose from the dead, 42 and He commanded us to preach uto the people and to testify that it is he which was **ordained of God to be the Judge** of quick and dead.

Acts 17:31 He has appointed a day in which he will **judge the world in righteousness** by that man whom he has ordained, giving assurance unto all men, in that He raised him from the dead.

John 8:15 You judge after the flesh; I judge no man.

John 12:47 If any man hear my words and believe them not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world but to save the world. 48 He that rejects me, and receives not my words, has one that judges him:

The word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.

Luke 19:21 I feared thee, because you are an austere man: you take up what you did not lay down, and reap that you did not sow. 22 **Out of your own mouth will I judge you**, you wicked servant.

Acts 13:45 When the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy, and spoke against Paul, contradicting and blaspheming. Paul and Barnabas said, "Seeing you put the word of God from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, Lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

Romans 14:13 Let us not therefore judge one another any more.

1Cor 6:1-3 Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the unjust and not before the saints? 2 Do you not know that you shall **judge the world**...3 Know ye not that we shall **judge angels**? How much more things that pertain to this life?

Col 2:16 **Let no man therefore judge you** in meat, or in drink,or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or the sabbath days: which are a shadow of things to come; **but the body of Christ**.

2Tim 4:1 I charge thee before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom.

Heb 12:22,23 Ye are come unto mount Zion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalm and to an innumerable company of angels, to the assembly and church of the firstborn, which is written in heaven, and to **God the Judge of all**.

James 2:12,13 They that shall be **judged by the law of liberty**: they that have showed no mercy, shall have judgment without mercy

Revelation 15:3,4 Song of Moses and the Lamb:

Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; Just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints. Who shall not fear thee and glorify thy name?

- 1 For thou only art holy; thou only art holy!
- 2 For all nations shall come and worship before thee!
- 3 For thy judgments are made manifest!
