

WordStudy: The Great I Will

I Am

The Great I AM introduces Himself at the burning bush. **Exodus 3:1-6**

When Moses is told to go tell Pharaoh, Let my people go, Moses asks, **Exodus 3:13,14**

"What shall I tell my people when they say, "What is the name of your God?"

And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM. Tell them, I AM has sent you unto them.

Long before this God said to Abraham,

- Gen 15:7 "I am the LORD that brought you out of Ur of the Chaldees." 2 chapters later, at age 99, Abram is told,
Gen 17:1 "I am the Almighty God" Abram falls on his face, and his name is changed to Abraham
Gen 31:11-13 "The angel of God spoke to Jacob in a dream, saying "I am the God of Bethel"
Exo 20 "I am the Lord thy God which brought you out of the house of bondage"
Sos 2:1 "I am the rose of Sharon, the lily of the vallies."
Eze 44:28 "I am their inheritance"
John 6:35 "I am the bread of life, the living bread come down from heaven"
John 8:12 "I am the light of the world"
John 10:7 "I am the door of the sheep"
John 10:11 "I am the good shepherd"
John 10:36 "I am the Son of God" and they picked up stones to stone him.
John 11:25 "I am the resurrection and the life"
John 15:1 "I am the true vine...you are the branches" vs 5
Rev 1:11 "I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last
Rev 1:18 "I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive forevermore!"
Rev 22:16 "I am the root and offspring of David, the bright and morning star"

Jesus, Jehovah Emmanuel, comes in the name of His Father John 5:43, the Great I AM.

But much more often he declared himself, **the Great I WILL.**

Look and listen to these great promises of God.

Gen 17:7 "I will establish my covenant between me and you and your seed ...for an everlasting covenant"
Ex 6:6 "I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians"

Ex 20:24 "I will come to you and I will bless you" when you sacrifice on an altar of earth
Ex 23:20 "I send an Angel (mine Angel vs 23) before you, to keep you in the way, (lead you)
Ex 33:14 "I will give you rest"...My presence shall go with thee.
Lev 26:12 "I will walk among you, and will be your God, and you shall be my people"
Gen 26:3 "I will be with you" the LORD said to Isaac, "and will bless you...I will give all these countries"
Gen 31:3 "I will be with you" the LORD said to Jacob after telling him to return home
Ex 3:12 "I will be with you" God promised Moses
Deut 31:23 "I will be with you" God said to Joshua
Josh 1:5 "I will be with you: "I will not fail you, nor forsake you"
Heb 13:5 I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
Judges 6:16 "I will be with you, and you shall smite the Midianites" the Angel of the LORD said to Gideon
Psalm 91:14-16 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him
I will set him on high, because he has known my name.
He shall call upon me, and I will answer him:
I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.
Isa 41:10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee; be not dismayed; for I am thy God:
I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; I will uphold thee with my righteous hand
Isa 43:2 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee...

Isa 44:3 I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground;
I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:
And they shall spring up among the grass, as willows by the water.

Joel 2:25 **I will restore to you the years that the locust have eaten**, the cankerwork, and the caterpillar.
 Joel 2:28 And It shall come to pass, that **I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh**; and your sons and your Daughters ahll prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions.
 Zech 3:4 I have caused thine iniquity to pass ..., and **I will clothe thee with a change of raiment**.
 Matt 5:19 Follow me, and **I will make you fishers of men**
 Matt 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest**.
 John 6:37 him that cometh to me **I will in no wise cast out**.
 John 6:44 No man can come to me, except the Father which has sent me draw him:
 And **I will raise him up** at the last day.
 John 14:3 **I will come again**, and receive you unto myself.
 John 14:18 I will Not leave you comfortless: **I will come to you**.
 Heb 8:10 This is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel;
 This is the covenant that I will make after those days, saith the Lord;
I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts.

Rev 2:7 Ephesus: **I will give** him that overcometh **to eat of the tree of life** in the midst of the paradise of God.
 Rev 2:10 Smyrna: Be faithful unto death, and **I will give you a crown of life**.
 Rev 2:16 Pergamos: To him that overcometh **will I give to eat of the hidden manna**
 and will give him a white stone with a new name written which no man knows
 Rev 2:21 Thyatira: **I will give power over the nations**. And **I will give him the morning star**.
 Rev 3:1 Sardis: **I will not blot out his name** out of the book of life; **I will confess his name**
 before my Father, and before his angels.
 Rev 3:7 Philadelphia: **I will make them** of the synagogue of Satan (say they are Jews and are not)
I will make them to come and worship before your feet,
 and **I will keep you from the hour of temptation**
 Him that overcometh **will I make a pillar in the temple of my God**, and he shall go out no more:
 And **I will write upon him the name of my God...and I will write upon him my new name**.
 Rev 3:16 Laodicea: **I will come in to him**, and **I will sup with him**, and he with me.
 Rev 21:4 God shall (will) wipe away all tears from their eyes.
I will give to him that is athirst of the fountain of **the water of life freely**.

The Son of God in His humanity wrestled with the very same fierce, apparently overwhelming, temptations that assail men—temptations to indulgence of appetite, to presumptuous venturing where God has not led them, and to the worship of the god of this world, to sacrifice an eternity of bliss for the fascinating pleasures of this life. Everyone will be tempted, but the Word declares that we shall not be tempted above our ability to bear. We may resist and defeat the wily foe. {Lt116-1899.10}

Every soul has a heaven to win, and a hell to shun. And the angelic agencies are all ready to come to the help of the tried and tempted soul. He, **the Son of the infinite God**, endured the test and trial in our behalf. The cross of Calvary stands vividly before every soul. When the cases of all are judged, and they are delivered to suffer for their contempt for God and their disregard of His honor in their disobedience, not one will have an excuse, not one will need to have perished. **It was left to their own choice** who should be their prince, Christ or Satan. **All the help Christ received, every man may receive in the great trial**.
